

# Quilter's Progress - Part 3

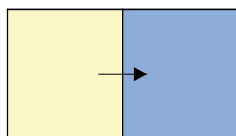
## Cutting

Save and label remnants as noted.

- From Fabric A, cut
  - 1 (one) 3-1/4" x WOF strip. Subcut
    - 2 (two) 3-1/4" x 3-1/4" squares. Cut along 1 diagonal to make 4 triangles.
    - Save and label the remnant for Part 6.
  - 1 (one) 1-3/4" x WOF strip. Subcut
    - 4 (four) 1-3/4" x 5" strips.
    - Save and label the remnant for Part 8.
- From Fabric B, cut
  - 1 (one) 2-3/4" x WOF strips. Subcut
    - 4 (four) 2-3/4" x 2-3/4" squares.
    - 2 (two) 2-1/4" x 2-3/4" rectangles. Trim to result in 2 (two) 2-1/4" x 2-1/4" squares.
    - Save and label the remnant for Part 6.
- From Fabric D, cut
  - 1 (one) 2-1/4" x WOF strips. Subcut
    - 2 (two) 2-1/4" x 2-1/4" squares.
    - 4 (four) 2-1/4" x 5" strips. Trim to result in 4 (four) 1-1/2" x 5" strips.
    - Save and label the remnant for Part 7.

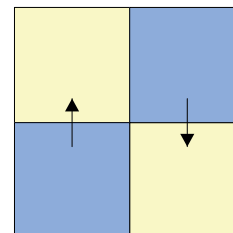
## Block 3 - Coxey's Camp

- Gather 2 (two) 2-1/4" x 2-1/4" Fabric B squares, 2 (two) 2-1/4" x 2-1/4" Fabric D squares, and 4 Fabric A triangles from 3-1/4" x 3-1/4" squares.
- Stitch a Fabric D square to the right side of each Fabric B square. Press the seam toward Fabric D. The result should measure 2-1/4" x 4".

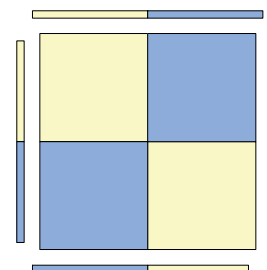


**Make 2**

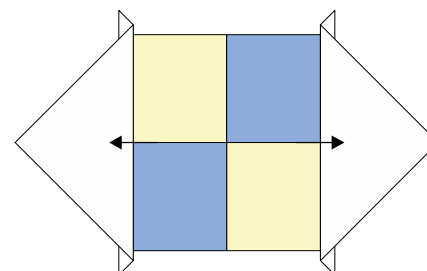
- Watching the orientation of the pieces, sew the 2-patches from step 2 into a 4-patch. Press and furl the seam. The result should measure 4" x 4".



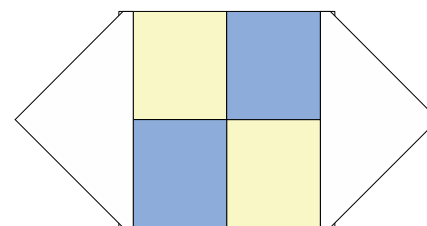
- Carefully trim the 4-patch to measure 3-3/4" x 3-3/4". The center of the 4-patch should be 1-7/8" from each of the trimmed edges.



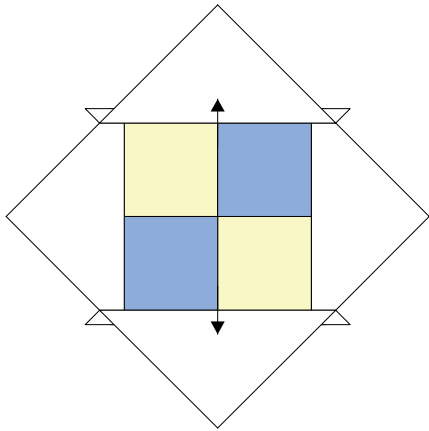
- Center and stitch Fabric A triangles to opposite sides of the trimmed 4-patch. Press the seams toward Fabric A.



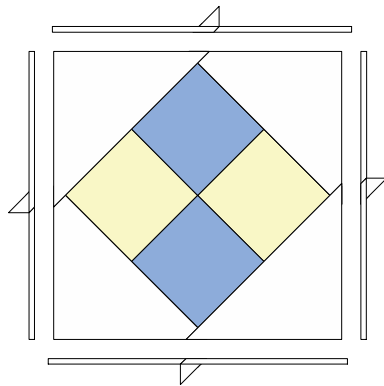
- Carefully trim the dog ears even with the sides of the 4-patch.



7. Center and stitch Fabric A triangles to the remaining 2 sides of the 4-patch. Press the seams toward Fabric A.

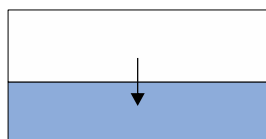


8. Carefully trim the step 7 unit to 5" x 5". The center of the 4-patch should be 2-1/2" from the edges of the trimmed unit. The corners of the 4-patch should be centered 2-1/2" from the sides and 1/4" from the edge.



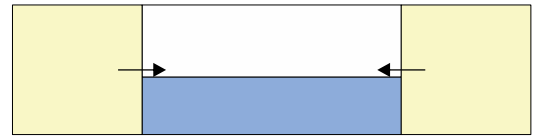
9. Gather 4 (four) 1-3/4" x 5" Fabric A strips and 4 (four) 1-1/2" x 5" Fabric D strips.

10. Stitch a Fabric A strip to a Fabric D strip. Press the seam toward Fabric D. The result should measure 2-3/4" x 5". Make 4.



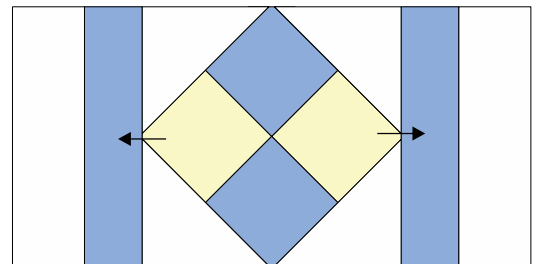

11. Stitch a 2-3/4" x 2-3/4" Fabric B square to the left and right ends of a step 10 unit. Press the seams away from Fabric B. The result should measure 2-3/4" x 9-1/2". Make 2.

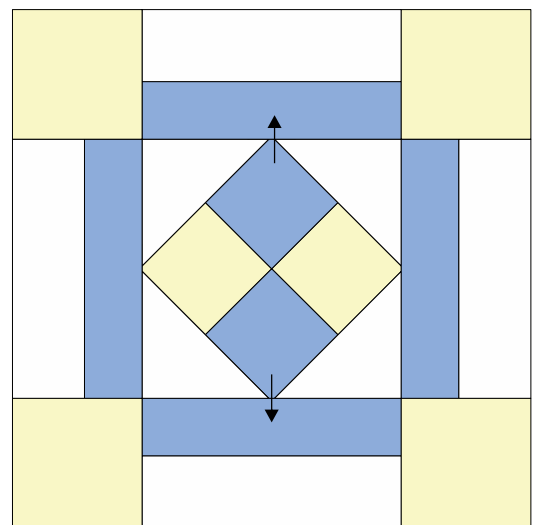

12. Stitch step 10 units to the left and right side of the step 8 unit. Press the seams toward Fabric D. The result should measure 5" x 9-1/2".



13. Stitch step 11 units to the top and bottom of the step 12 unit. Press toward the step 11 units. The result is Block 3 (Coxey's Camp) and should measure 9-1/2" x 9-1/2".



**Coxey's Camp**
