

# Quilter's Progress - Part 5

## Cutting

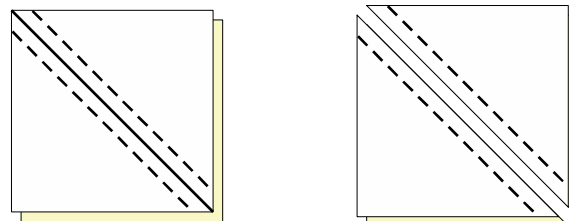
Save and label remnants as noted.

- From Fabric A, cut
  - 1 (one) 5-3/4" x WOF strip. Subcut
    - 1 (one) 5-3/4" x 5-3/4" square. Cut on 1 diagonal to make 2 large triangles; only 1 large triangle is needed.
    - 2 (two) 2-3/4" x 5-3/4" strips. Trim to result in 2 (two) 2-3/4" x 5" rectangles.
    - Save and label the remnant for Part 9.
  - 1 (one) 3-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut
    - 4 (four) 3-1/2" x 3-1/2" squares. Cut only 2 of the squares on 1 diagonal to make 4 triangles.
    - Save and label the remnant for Part 8.
- From Fabric B, cut
  - 1 (one) 3-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut
    - 3 (three) 3-1/2" x 3-1/2" squares. Cut only 2 of the squares on 1 diagonal to make 4 triangles; only 3 triangles are needed.
    - Save and label the remnant for Part 8.
- From Fabric D, cut
  - 1 (one) 5-3/4" x WOF strip. Subcut
    - 1 (one) 5-3/4" x 5-3/4" square. Cut on 1 diagonal to make 2 large triangles; only 1 large triangle is needed.
    - Save and label the remnant for Part 8.
  - Using the 4-1/4" remnant from Part 4, cut
    - 1 (one) 3-1/2" x 4-1/4" rectangle. Trim to result in 1 (one) 3-1/2" x 3-1/2" square.
    - Save and label the remnant for Part 6.
- From Fabric E, cut
  - 1 (one) 3-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut
    - 1 (one) 3-1/2" x 3-1/2" square. Cut on 1 diagonal to make 2 triangles; only 1 triangle is needed.
    - Save and label the remnant for Part 10.

## Block 5 - Flower Basket

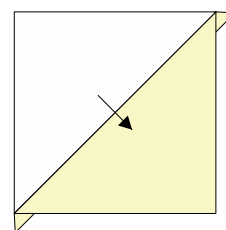
- Draw a diagonal line on the back of the 2 (two) 3-1/2" x 3-1/2" Fabric A squares.

- Layer, right sides together, a Fabric A square with a 3-1/2" x 3-1/2" Fabric B square. Stitch seams 1/4" from both sides of the diagonal line.



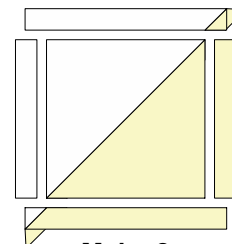
- Cut on the drawn line to separate the unit into 2 HSTs.

- Press the seams toward Fabric B.



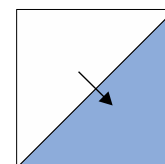
**Make 2**

- Making sure the seam goes through the corners, trim each Fabric A/B HST to 2-3/4" x 2-3/4".

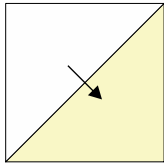
- Repeat steps 2 through 5 with a Fabric A square and the 3-1/2" x 3-1/2" Fabric D square to make 2 (two) 2-3/4" x 2-3/4" Fabric A/D HSTs.



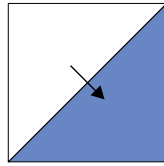

7. Gather 2 Fabric A triangles, 1 Fabric B triangle, and 1 Fabric E triangle.

8. Matching the long edges, carefully stitch a Fabric A triangle to the Fabric B triangle. Press the seam toward Fabric B. Trim the resulting Fabric A/B HST to 2-3/4" x 2-3/4" as in step 5.



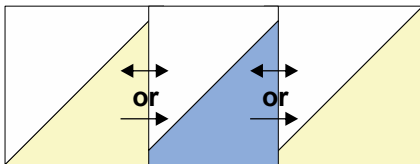

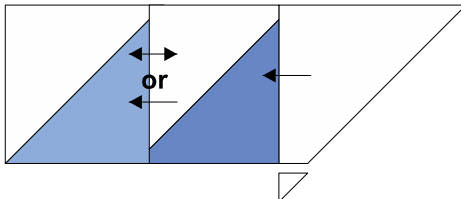

9. Matching the long edges, carefully stitch a Fabric A triangle to the Fabric E triangle. Press the seam toward Fabric E. Trim the resulting Fabric A/E HST to 2-3/4" x 2-3/4" as in step 5.

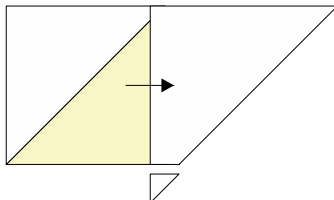
10. Stitch 2 Fabric A/B HSTs and a Fabric A/D HST together as shown. Press the seams open or to the right. The result should measure 2-3/4" x 7-1/4".



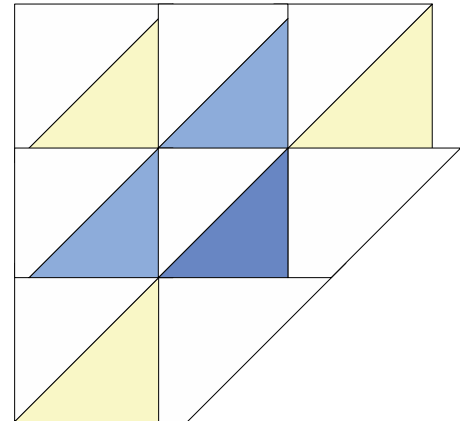
11. Stitch a Fabric A/D HST, A Fabric A/E HST, and a Fabric A triangle together as shown. Press the seams as indicated by the arrows. Trim the Fabric A triangle even with the bottom of the HSTs.



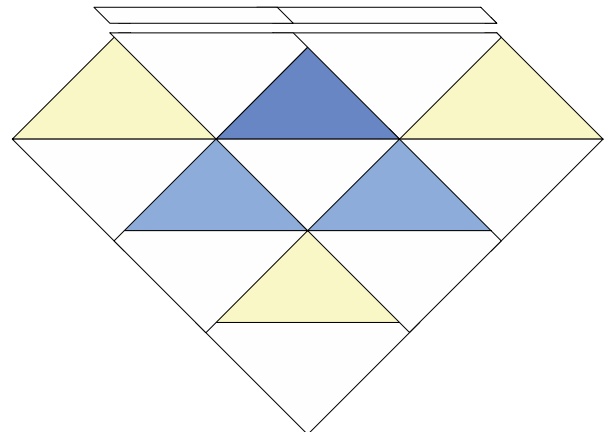
12. Stitch a Fabric A/B HST and a Fabric A triangle together as shown. Press the seam toward the triangle. Trim the Fabric A triangle even with the bottom of the HST.



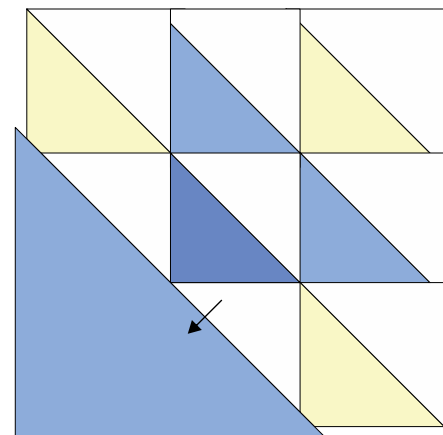
13. Stitch the step 10, 11, and 12 units together as shown. Press the seams as desired.



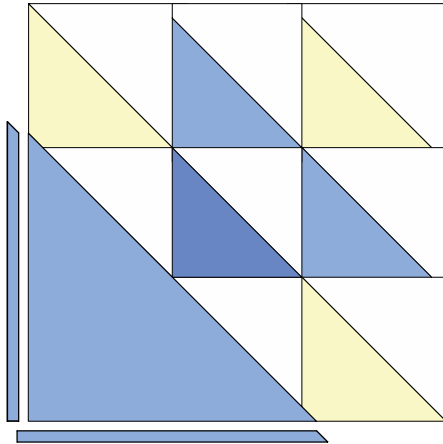
14. Carefully trim the edge of the Fabric A triangles to leave a 1/4" seam allowance beyond the corner of the Fabric A/E HST. Make sure you are trimming the edge parallel to the long edges of the Fabric B and Fabric E triangles.



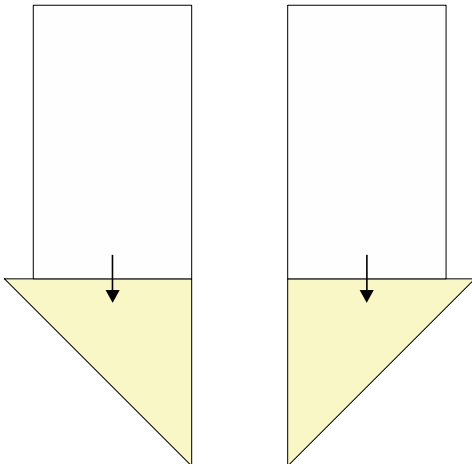
15. Stitch a Fabric D large triangle to the trimmed edge of the unit from step 14. Press the seam toward the added triangle.



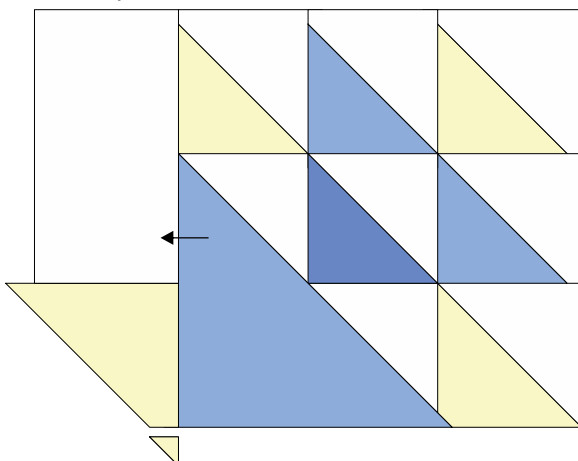
16. Carefully trim the edges even with the HST. The unit should measure 7-1/4" x 7-1/4".



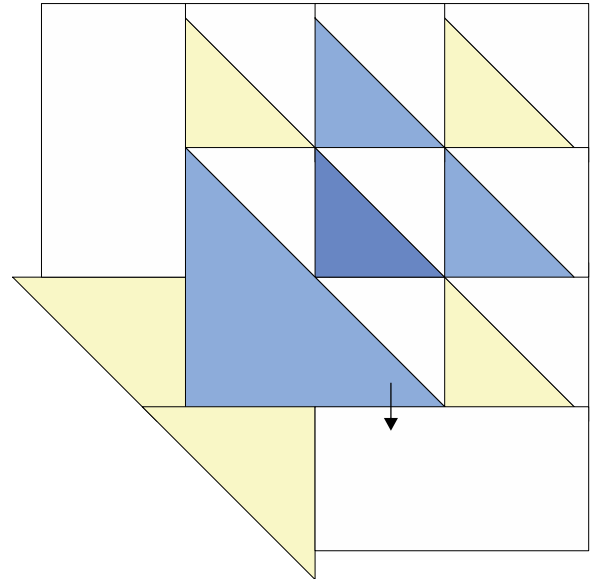
17. Watching the orientation, stitch Fabric B triangles to 2-3/4" x 5" Fabric A rectangles. Note: The 2 units are mirror images. Press the seams toward the triangles.



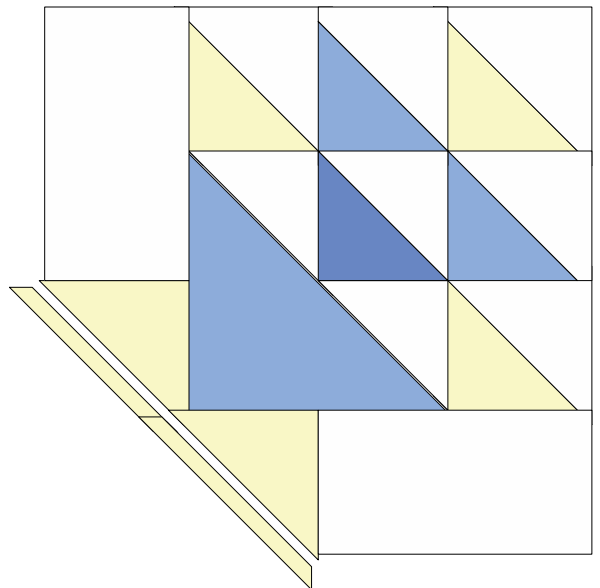
18. Watching the orientation, stitch the left step 17 unit to the left side of the step 16 unit. Press the seam toward the step 17 unit. Trim the dog ear even with the step 16 unit.



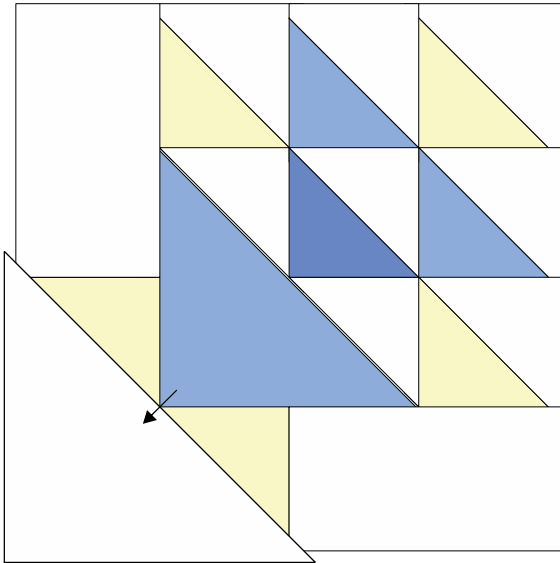
19. Watching the orientation, stitch the right step 17 unit to the bottom of the step 18 unit. Press the seam toward the step 17 unit.



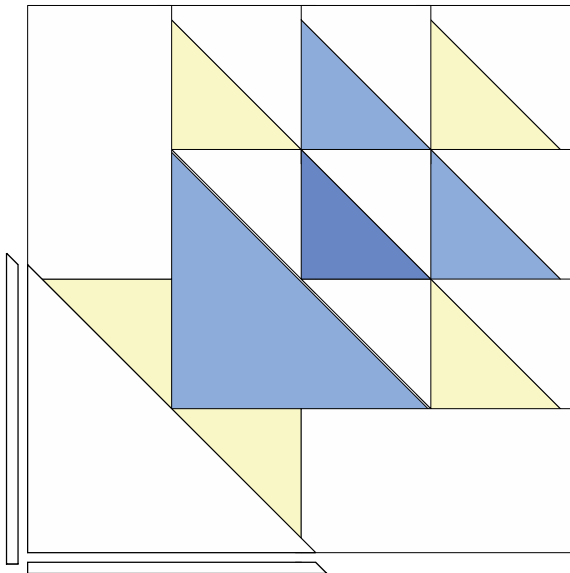
20. Carefully trim the edge of the Fabric B triangles to leave a 1/4" seam allowance beyond the corners of the large Fabric D triangle. Make sure you are trimming the edge parallel to the long edge of the large Fabric D triangle.



21. Stitch a Fabric A large triangle to the trimmed edge of the unit from step 20. Press the seam toward the added triangle.



22. Carefully trim the edges even with the Fabric A rectangles. The result is Block 5 (Flower Basket) and should measure 9-1/2" x 9-1/2".
