

Quilter's Progress - Part 7

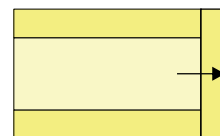

Cutting

Save and label remnants as noted.

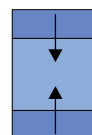
- From 2" remnant of Fabric A from Part 2, cut
 - 1 (one) 2" x 2" square.
 - 4 (four) 2" x 5-3/4" strips.
 - Save and label the remnant for Part 8.
- From 2-1/2" remnant of Fabric B from Part 4, cut
 - 1 (one) 2-1/2" x 15" strip. Trim down to 1-3/4" x 15" strip.
- From 3-1/2" remnant of Fabric C from Part 4, cut
 - 1 (one) 3-1/2" x 15" strip. Subcut into
 - 2 (two) 1" x 15" strips.
 - 2 (two) 1" x 2-3/4" strips.
- From 2-1/4" remnant of Fabric D from Part 3, cut
 - 1 (one) 2-1/4" x 15" strip. Trim down to 1-3/4" x 15" strip.
- From 2-1/2" remnant of Fabric E from Part 4, cut
 - 1 (one) 2-1/2" x 15" strip. Subcut into
 - 2 (two) 1" x 15" strips.
 - 1 (one) 2-1/2" x 2-3/4" rectangle. Subcut into
 - 2 (two) 1" x 2-3/4" strips.

- Stitch 1" x 2-3/4" Fabric C strips to the end of the 2-3/4" x 3-3/4" Fabric C/B/C segments. Press the seam toward Fabric C. The result should measure 2-3/4" x 4-1/4". Repeat to make 2 Fabric C/B/C-C Units.

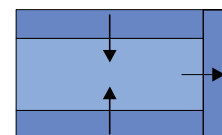

- Repeat step 1 through 3 using 2 (two) 1" x 15" Fabric E strips, and 1 (one) 1-3/4" x 15" Fabric D strip. Cut 2 (two) 2" x 2-3/4" Fabric E/D/E segments and 2 (two) 2-2/4" x 3-3/4" Fabric E/D/E segments. Make 2 (two) 2-3/4" x 4-1/4" Fabric E/D/E-E units.



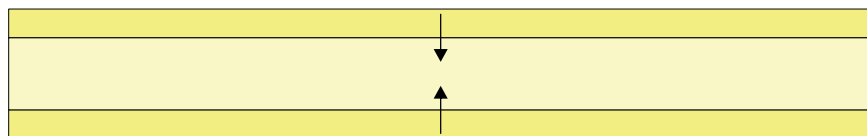

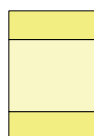

Block 7 - Woven Square

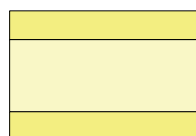
- Make a strip set using the 2 (two) 1" x 15" Fabric C strips and the 1-3/4" x 15" Fabric B strip. Press the seams toward Fabric B. The result should measure 2-3/4" x 15".



- From the step 1 strip set, cut 2 Fabric C/B/C segments measuring 2" x 2-3/4" and 2 Fabric C/B/C segments measuring 2-3/4" x 3-3/4".



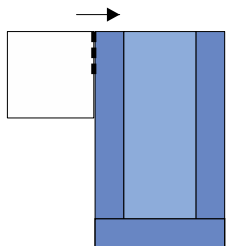

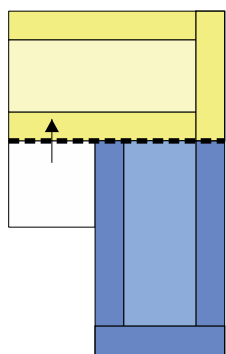

5. Use partial seams and standard 1/4" seams to stitch 2 (two) 2-3/4" x 4-1/4" Fabric C/B/C-C units and 2 (two) 2-3/4" x 4-1/4" Fabric E/D/E-E units around the 2" x 2" Fabric A square. Press the seams away from the square. The result should measure 6-1/2" x 6-1/2".

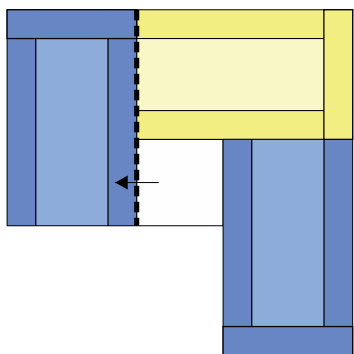
Start at the middle of the Fabric A square and stitch a Fabric E/D/E unit to the top corner as shown. Press the seam away from Fabric A.



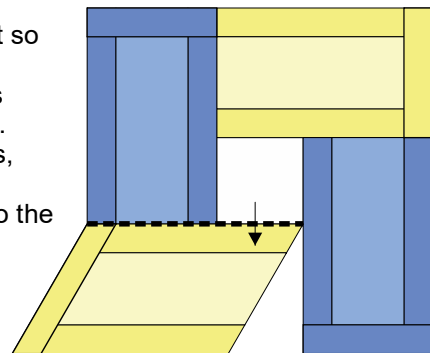
Rotate the unit so Fabric E/D/E-E unit is toward the bottom. Nesting seams, stitch a Fabric C/B/C-C unit to the unit with a complete seam. Press the seam away from Fabric A.



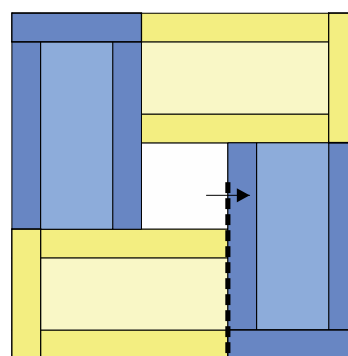
Rotate the unit so the Fabric C/B/C-C unit is toward the bottom. Nesting seams, stitch a Fabric E/D/E-E unit to the unit with a complete seam. Press the seam away from Fabric A.



Rotate the unit so the first Fabric E/D/E-E unit is toward the top. Nesting seams, stitch a Fabric C/B/C-C unit to the unit with a complete seam. Press the seam away from Fabric A.



Rotate the unit and nest seams. Finish stitching the partial seam. Press the seam away from Fabric A.



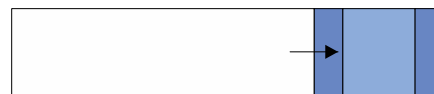
6. Gather 2 (two) 2" x 2-3/4" Fabric C/B/C segments, 2 (two) 2" x 2-3/4" Fabric E/D/E segments, and 4 (four) 2" x 5-3/4" Fabric A strips.

7. Stitch a Fabric C/B/C segment to a Fabric A strip. Press the seam toward Fabric C. The result should measure 2-3/4" x 8". Repeat to make 2.



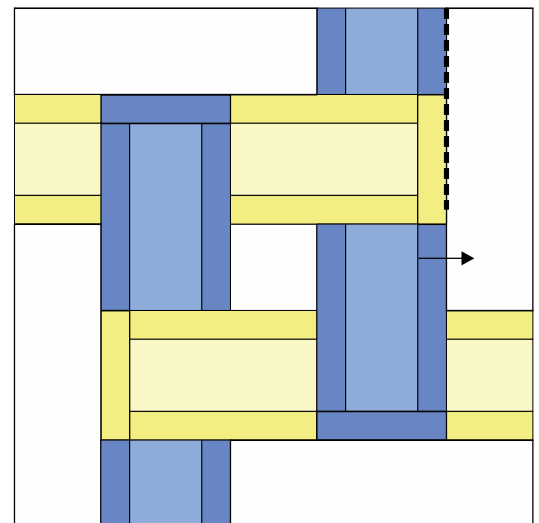
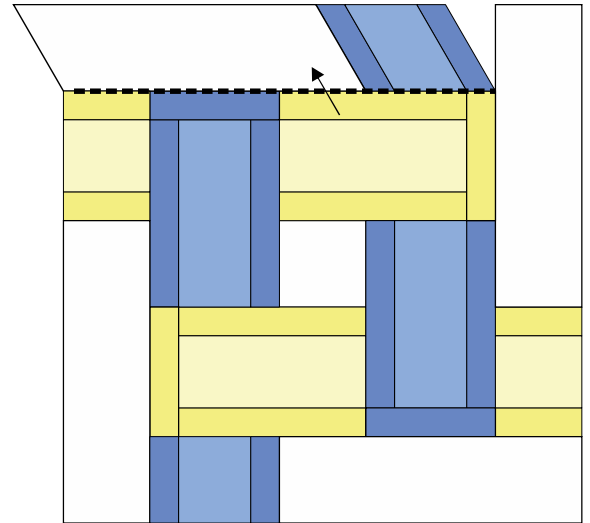
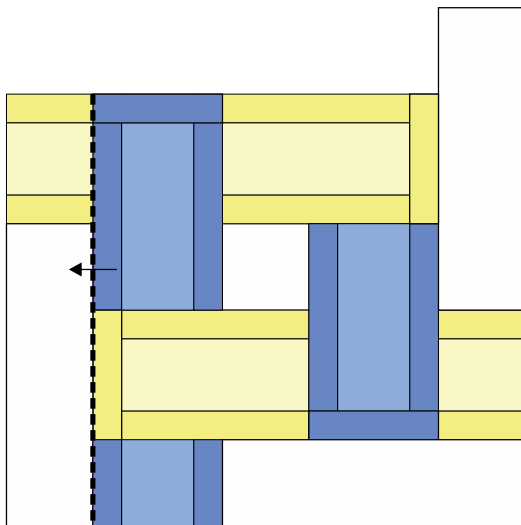
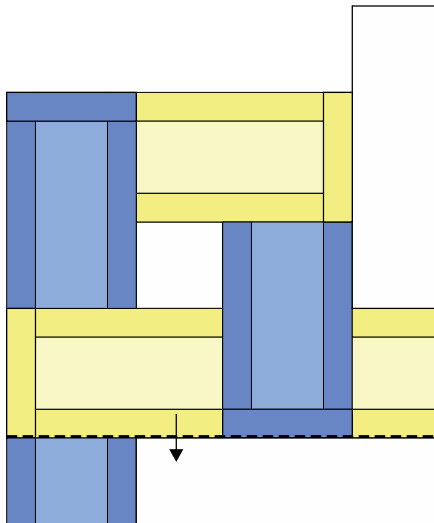
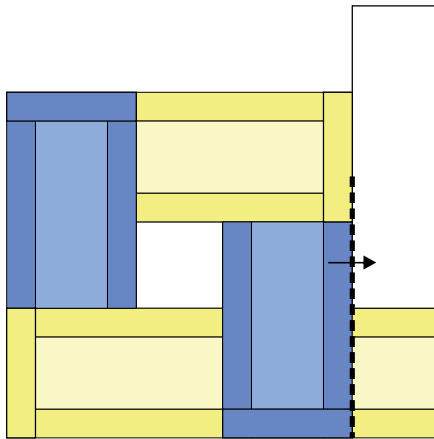

8. Stitch a Fabric E/D/E segment to a Fabric A strip. Press the seam toward Fabric E. The result should measure 2-3/4" x 8". Repeat to make 2.

9. Use partial seams and standard 1/4" seams to stitch 2 step 6 and 2 step 7 units around the step 4 pieced square. Press the seams away from the pieced square. The result is Block 7 (Woven Square) and should measure 9-1/2" x 9-1/2".



Woven Square
