

Quilter's Progress - Part 8

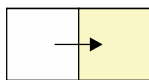
Cutting

Save and label remnants as noted.

- From 3-1/2" remnant of Fabric A from Part 5, cut
 - 4 (four) 3-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangles. Trim to result in 4 (four) 3" x 4-1/2" rectangles.
- From 2" remnant of Fabric A from Part 7, cut
 - 1 (one) 2" x 2" square.
- From 1-3/4" remnant of Fabric A from Part 3, cut
 - 4 (four) 1-3/4" x 1-3/4" squares.
- From 3-1/2" remnant of Fabric B from Part 5, cut
 - 3 (three) 1-3/4" x 3-1/2" rectangles. Subcut into
 - 6 (six) 1-3/4" x 1-3/4" squares.
 - 1 (one) 3" x 3-1/2" rectangle. Subcut into
 - 2 (two) 1-3/4" x 3" rectangles.
 - 1 (one) 3-1/4" x 3-1/2" rectangle. Subcut into
 - 2 (two) 1-3/4" x 3-1/4" rectangles.
 - Save and label the remnant for Part 11.
- From 5-3/4" remnant of Fabric D from Part 5, cut
 - 1 (one) 5-3/4" x 9" strip. Subcut into
 - 3 (three) 1-3/4" x 9" strips. Subcut into
 - 2 (two) 1-3/4" x 3-1/4" rectangles.
 - 2 (two) 1-3/4" x 3" rectangles.
 - 6 (six) 1-3/4" x 1-3/4" squares.
 - Save and label the remnant for Part 9.

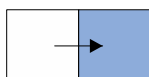
Block 8 - Intertwined

- Stitch a 1-3/4" x 1-3/4" Fabric A square to a 1-3/4" x 1-3/4" Fabric B square. Press the seams away from Fabric A. The resulting Fabric A/B 2-patch should measure 1-3/4" x 3". Make 2.



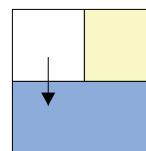

- Stitch a 1-3/4" x 1-3/4" Fabric A square to a 1-3/4" x 1-3/4" Fabric D square. Press the seams away from Fabric A. The resulting Fabric A/D 2-patch should measure 1-3/4" x 3". Make 2.



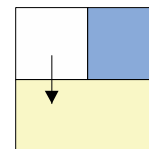

- Watching the orientation, stitch a 1-3/4" x 3" Fabric D rectangle to a Fabric A/B 2-patch. Press the seam toward Fabric D. The result should measure 3" x 3". Make 2.

- Watching the orientation, stitch a 1-3/4" x 3" Fabric B rectangle to a Fabric A/D 2-patch. Press the seam toward Fabric B. The result should measure 3" x 3". Make 2.

- Draw a diagonal line on the back of 4 (four) 1-3/4" x 1-3/4" Fabric B and 4 (four) 1-3/4" x 1-3/4" Fabric D squares.

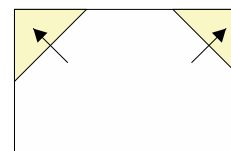

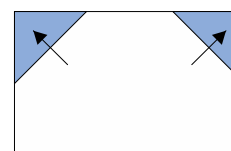

- Position Fabric B squares on the corners of a long side of a 3" x 4-1/2" Fabric A rectangle. Stitch on the drawn line. Finger press toward the Fabric B squares. The edges of the rectangle and the square should align. Trim the seam to 1/4". Press the seam toward Fabric B. The unit should measure 3" x 4-1/2". Make 2.



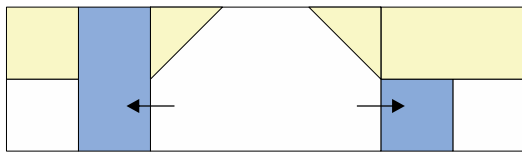

- Repeat step 6 using Fabric D squares.



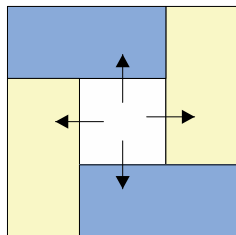

8. Watching the orientation, stitch a step 3 unit to the left side and a step 4 unit to the right side of a step 6 unit. Press the seams away from the step 6 unit. The result measures 3" x 9-1/2". Make 2.

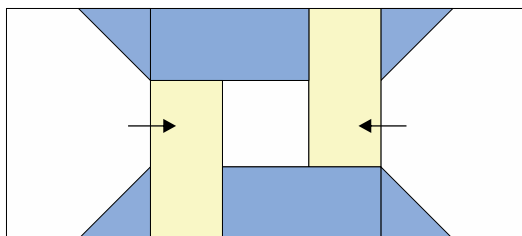

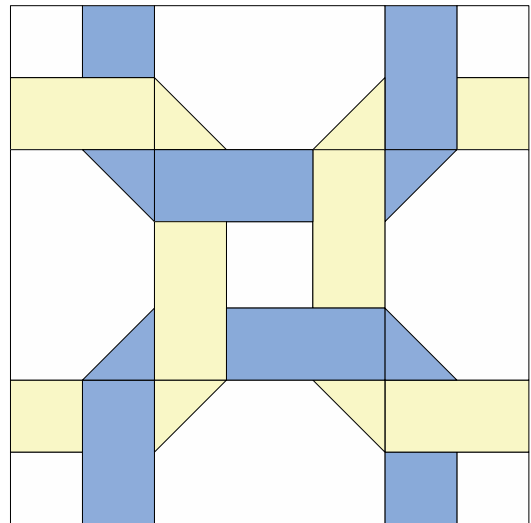
9. Use partial seams and standard 1/4" seams to stitch 2 (two) 1-3/4" x 3-1/4" Fabric B rectangles and 2 (two) 1-3/4" x 3-1/4" Fabric D rectangles around a 2" x 2" Fabric A square. Press the seams away from the pieced square. The result should measure 4-1/2" x 4-1/2". (If you need a refresher on partial seams, refer to Part 7.)



10. Stitch a step 7 unit to the left and right sides of the step 9 unit. Press the seams toward the step 9 unit. The result should measure 4-1/2" x 9-1/2".



11. Watching the orientation, stitch a step 8 unit to the top and bottom of the step 10 unit. Press the seams in any direction. The result is Block 8 (Intertwined) and should measure 9-1/2" x 9-1/2".
