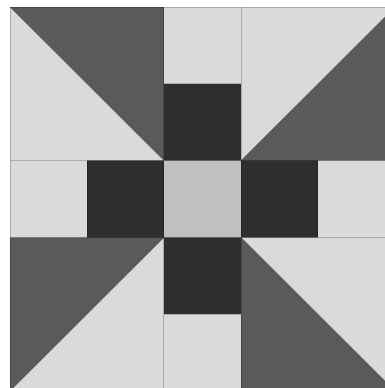


Month 3: Propeller (provided February 2017; share March 2017)

This block is an uneven 9-patch. As shown, this block uses 4 fabrics: Fabric 2, Fabric 3, Fabric 5 and Fabric 6.



Fabric needed: Cut the listed pieces for each fabric. Be sure each piece is cut accurately.

Fabric 2	4 - 2-1/4" x 2-1/4" squares 1 - 1-1/4" x 8-1/2" strip	2 - 4-3/4" x 4-3/4" squares 1 - 2-3/4" x 8-1/2" strip	4 - 4-3/4" x 4-3/4" squares 1 - 2-3/4" x 17" strip
Fabric 3	2 - 1" x 1" squares	1 - 2" x 2" squares	2 - 2" x 2" squares
Fabric 5	4 - 2-1/4" x 2-1/4" squares	2 - 4-3/4" x 4-3/4" squares	4 - 4-3/4" x 4-3/4" squares
Fabric 6	1 - 1" x 8-1/2" strip	1 - 2" x 8-1/2" strip	1 - 2" x 17" strip

Piecing Instructions for 9" blocks (3")

Note: Watch carefully as you stitch.

1. Use the Fabric 2 and 5 squares to make HSTs measuring 4-1/4" x 4-1/4" (1-3/4" x 1-3/4").
 - a) Draw a diagonal line on the back of each Fabric 2 square.
 - b) Layer a Fabric 2 and Fabric 5 square together.
 - c) Stitch a 1/4" seams on either side of the drawn line.
 - d) Cut along the drawn line.
 - e) Press the seam toward Fabric 5.
 - f) Trim each HST to 4-1/4" x 4-1/4" (1-3/4" x 1-3/4").
2. Stitch a Fabric 2 strip to each Fabric 6 strip. Press the seam away from Fabric 2.
3. Cut each strip set into 2" (1") pieces. (Need 4 for each block.)
4. Arrange the units and sew 3 rows, pressing the seams away from the strip pieced unit.
5. Nest the seams and stitch the rows together, pressing and furling the seams. The block should measure 9-1/2" x 9-1/2" (3-1/2" x 3-1/2").
