

Month 12: Second border & Eyelash binding (provided November 2017; share December 2017)

Fabric needed: Cut the listed pieces for each fabric.

	3" blocks on-point	9" block	9" blocks on-point
Fabric 3	3 - 1-1/2" WOF strips	5 - 1-1/2" WOF strips	7 - 1-1/2" WOF strips
Fabric 5	3 - 1-1/4" WOF strips	5 - 1-1/4" WOF strips	7 - 1-1/4" WOF strips
Fabric 7	3 - 2" WOF strips 2 - 2" x 21" 2 - 2" x 19-3/8"	5 - 5" WOF strips 2 - 5" x 36-1/2" 2 - 5" x 45-1/2"	7 - 5" WOF strips 2 - 5" x 62-3/8" 2 - 5" x 56-1/2"

Instructions

Note: Watch carefully as you stitch.

1. Stitch the Fabric 7 strips together, end-to-end, using diagonal seams. Shorten the stitch length slightly and press the seams open.
2. Subcut the long Fabric 7 strip into 4 strips as listed based on your blocks and setting:
 - a) 9" blocks in straight setting: 2 - 36-1/2" long and 2 - 45-1/2" long
 - b) 9" blocks in on-point setting: 2 - 62-3/8" long and 2 - 56-1/2" long
 - c) 3" blocks in on-point setting: 2 - 21" long and 2 - 19-3/8" long
3. Sew the first set of Fabric 7 strips to either side of the quilt. Press the seams toward the added border.
4. Sew the second set of Fabric 7 strips to the top and bottom of the quilt. Press the seams toward the added borders.
5. Layer and quilt as desired.

Eyelash Binding

1. Stitch the Fabric 3 strips together, end-to-end, using diagonal seams. Shorten the stitch length slightly and press the seams open.
2. Stitch the Fabric 5 strips together, end-to-end, using diagonal seams. Shorten the stitch length slightly and press the seams open.
3. Stitch the long Fabric 3 and Fabric 5 strips together. Press the seam toward Fabric 5.
4. Press the strip set made in Step 3 in half, lengthwise to make the eyelash binding.
5. With raw edges even, stitch the binding to the back of the quilt with the Fabric 3 side of the binding facing up. Miter the corners.
6. Press the binding to the right side of the quilt. Now stitch from the front of the quilt through the Fabric 3 strip to finish attaching the binding. If desired, use a heavier thread or a decorative stitch to add another element of interest to the quilt.
